- Operating room temperature: 15°C 35°C room temperature
- The recommended operation time of the wheel with continuous force feedback activity is 1 hour.
- Excessive use may cause health risks. We recommend to take a break of 5 minutes every 20 minutes, and do not drive for more than 2 hours per day.
- Not intended for children under the age of 6 years old. Contains small pieces which pose a choking hazard!
- This device contains components that cannot be repaired by the user, unauthorized disassembly
  or modification will void the warranty.

- The Podium Advanced Paddle Module must be connected to a compatible steering wheel and never to any other power source besides that!


#### GENERAL NOTES

- For use of the Podium Advanced Paddle Module please make sure that you have installed the most
  recent firmware of your Fanatec wheel base and steering wheel. The Podium Advanced Paddle
  Module does not have a firmware itself. You can obtain the driver package including firmware from
  www.fanatec.com/mediagallery. A PC is required to update your firmware.
- All specifications in this document are subject to change. The Podium Advanced Paddle Module, firmware, and / or PC driver may be updated to implement new features or general improvements.
- This manual mentions Fanatec steering wheels and/or other products which are not included within the Podium Advanced Paddle Module package and sold separately. You can obtain them from the Fanatec webshop: www.fanatec.com
- This manual discusses assembly, connections, and functions related to Fanatec<sup>®</sup> steering wheels

#### COMPATIBILITY

The Podium Advanced Paddle Module can be used with several Fanatec products, including the ClubSport Steering Wheel Formula V2 range, the ClubSport Universal Hub for Xbox One, and the Podium Hub. Please check the compatibility section of the Podium Advanced Paddle Module product page on our webshop for detailed compatibility information: www.fanatec.com

The Podium Advanced Paddle Module is compatible with PC and other systems, depending on the compatibility of your wheel base and / or your steering wheel. For example you need an Xbox One licensed Fanatec steering wheel attached on any Fanatec wheel base to use the Podium Advanced Paddle Module on Xbox One.

Please check the compatibility information of your wheel base and steering wheel.

**IMPORTANT:** Please make sure you have installed the latest firmware on your wheel base and steering wheel. A Windows PC is required to update your firmware.






#### MODULE BASIC ASSEMBLY


IMPORTANT: For compatibility information and additional assembly instructions please refer to the manual of the selected steering wheel.

4.2 Setup for steering wheels with a diameter smaller than 28 cm (Formula):





#### **ATTACHMENT TO 5 CLUBSPORT STEERING** WHEEL FORMULA V2



2 Remove lower back cover.

Disconnect the existing shifter paddle connectors.

**NOTE:** Carefully pull on the plastic connectors and not the cables of the standard shifter paddle modules.

Loosen the shifter paddle bolts marked in gold using a 2.5 mm Allen key (not included) for clearance to the mounting bolts of the standard paddle modules.

#### Attach the back cover again, insert and tighten the two bolts using the 2 mm Allen key (E) as in the first step above.


Connect the Podium Advanced Paddle Module connectors to the correct sockets.


Paddle Module and tighten the M5x16 mm mounting bolts (I) using the 4 mm Allen key (F).




- Carefully insert the standard paddle module connectors and push the cable through.
- **NOTE:** Handle bolts and spacers with care as the magnets may exert an attractive force on them.

- Loosen the mounting bolts as highlighted in gold in picture by using the Allen key 4 mm (F) to detach the standard paddle modules.
- 6 Carefully remove the standard paddle module cables and connectors.

#### ATTACHMENT TO CLUBSPORT STEERING WHEEL UNIVERSAL HUB FOR XBOX ONE

Loosen and remove the four locking bolts on the back of the Universal Hub main body. Detach the front cover to open the housing and have access to the connectors inside.



2 Open the Universal Hub and disconnect the standard shifter paddle cables.

**NOTE:** Carefully pull on the plastic connectors and not the cables of the standard shifter paddle modules.







3 Loosen the mounting bolts circled in gold in the picture below using the 4 mm Allen key (F) to detach the standard paddle modules.



4 Store the mounting bolts with the standard shifter paddles for later use.







5 There are two mounting positions on the sides of the Universal Hub, depending on the steering wheel used. Each position has a different bolt length requirement.

The picture below explains which bolts are required for which position.



Position 1 - M5x16 mm bolts (I) Position 2 - M5x12 mm bolts (J)

**NOTE:** Handle bolts and spacers with care as the magnets may exert an attractive force on them.

6 Attach the Podium Advanced Paddle Module using the correct bolts for the chosen position as explained above and tighten them using the 4 mm Allen key (F).









Route the Podium Advanced Paddle Module cables through the rubber holes of the Universal Hub housing and plug the connectors in the correct sockets. Then place the front plate on top of the case.



ATTENTION: Position the cables carefully inside the housing to avoid damage!

8 Insert and tighten the four locking bolts again.








#### ATTACHMENT TO PODIUM HUB


Loosen the three highlighted screws on the plastic front cover using the 2 mm Allen key (E).



2 Remove the plastic front cover.




3 Attach the Podium Advanced Paddle Module using the M5x16 mm bolts (I) and tighten them using the 4 mm Allen key (F).








Connect the Podium Advanced Paddle Module cables to the correct sockets.



5 Attach the plastic front cover again, insert and tighten the three screws using the 2 mm Allen key (E).

ATTENTION: Position the cables carefully before attaching the plastic front cover to avoid damage!

#### ANALOGUE PADDLE MODES

To switch the Mode of your Podium Advanced Paddle Module you need to enter the Tuning Menu. This can be accessed using the FanaLab software or a button/display module. Use the centre multi-position switch A, B, C, or D if available on the selected steering wheel. (E.g: ClubSport Formula V2)

- Clutch bite point left & right paddle work in parallel. The paddle that is pressed further is valid.
- Handbrake + Clutch Left: handbrake; right: clutch
- Brake + Throttle Left: brake; right: throttle
- Mappable analog axes Paddle can be mapped as two additional axes, but be aware these are shared with the joystick.

There are two ways to operate the clutch bite point feature, in either case the paddle mode switch must always be set to position A.

- 1. Simplified mode:
- Press both clutch paddles simultaneously to 5% or more to activate, move both paddles up to 100%.
- Release one paddle while keeping the other fully pressed. The display now shows the percentage value of the released paddle while the car's clutch is still fully pressed.
- Set the released paddle to the percentage where your car's clutch starts to bite (recommended to evaluate that by test drives before).
- As soon as the virtual start lights turn green, completely release the fully pressed paddle and the clutch is immediately at the bite point, held by the other paddle.
- Then release the other paddle with the correct speed to achieve the optimum launch acceleration.





- 2. Advanced mode:
- Pull both analogue paddles simultaneously to maximum and hold them there, display shows 100%.
- Press the FunkySwitch<sup>™</sup> down to lower the percentage to the bite point which you want to adjust, fitting your car best (recommended to evaluate that by test drives before).
- Release the paddles to set and store the value. Note: You can have individual stored values for each Tuning Menu slot S\_1 ... S\_5.
- At race start, pull both paddles again to activate the bite point mode, release one of these paddles and the clutch will immediately be at the bite point.
- As soon as the virtual start lights turn green, release the other paddle with the correct speed to achieve the optimum launch acceleration.
